Student participation in commencement exercises is on a voluntary basis. A student who chooses not to participate must pick up his or her diploma from the Marble Falls High School Counseling Office after 10:00 am on June 1st.

Walking the stage at graduation is a privilege.

Students who choose to participate in the ceremony **<u>must sign</u>** a commencement participation commitment and abide by the following regulations:

- 1. **Must** meet all Academic requirements to participate.
- 2. ALL financial obligations must be paid and laptop check out cleared (paid for or returned) before the Commencement practice date on May 27th.
- 3. Students who are in violation of any MFHS discipline code during the spring semester that warrants suspension, or DAEP placement that includes the Commencement date will NOT participate in Commencement.
- 4. In order to participate in the Commencement ceremony, a student **MUST** attend Commencement practice.
- 5. All males must wear a button-down shirt or nice collared and slacks (no jeans or shorts) with close-toed dress footwear (no tennis shoes or sandals) for the ceremony. Boys cannot wear earrings or facial piercings.
- 6. All females must wear an appropriate dress (nothing strapless) or slacks (no shorts) with an appropriate top (nothing strapless) with dress footwear (no tennis shoes). Shoes cannot be spiked heels; flats are strongly encouraged. Girls cannot wear facial piercings.
- 7. Masks are required when indoors and optional when outdoors (unless circumstances change).
- 8. An inspection by an Assistant Principal or other assigned staff member will be conducted before the processional. Those students in violation will be allowed to correct the infraction. Those who refuse will NOT be allowed to participate in the program.
- 9. No alterations/additions/decorations to cap or gown. Students may only wear regalia earned at MFHS and provided by the school.
- 10. Students are permitted to have a single key with them during the ceremony. All other personal items must be turned in at check in to be returned at the end of the ceremony.
- 11. Misconduct, distractions, and/or defiance of commencement procedures will not be allowed. Students who do not comply with the rules will be removed from the commencement activities.
- 12. The Student Code of Conduct and all policies relating to student conduct and dress code that are applicable during the school year will remain in force until the end of the commencement activities.
